- b) The dance must be continuous with no breaks between movements;
- c) It would be desirable if the dance were to be based on a cultural or folklore theme from the team's native country;
- d) Competing teams may use pre-recorded music or can provide their own live music for their performances and also, if the dance is theme based, a short written description of the story to the dance, and of the dance itself.
